

Ring Size Guide

The String or Paper Test

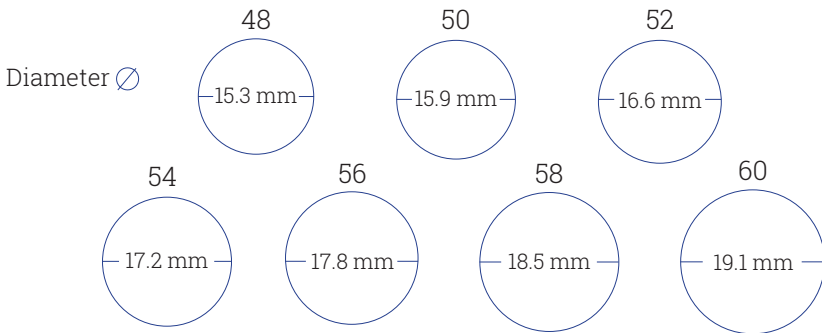
Cut a piece of paper or string and wrap it snugly around your finger at the base of the knuckle, then mark where the ends overlap. Lay it flat and measure the length in millimeters, and then use this chart to find the correct ring size in the top row.

Find Your PANDORA Ring Size

Print out this page and place one of your rings against the circle. When the circle and the internal ring diameter match, you have found your correct ring size. Please note that printers vary and may not print to scale, and that this chart is for reference only.



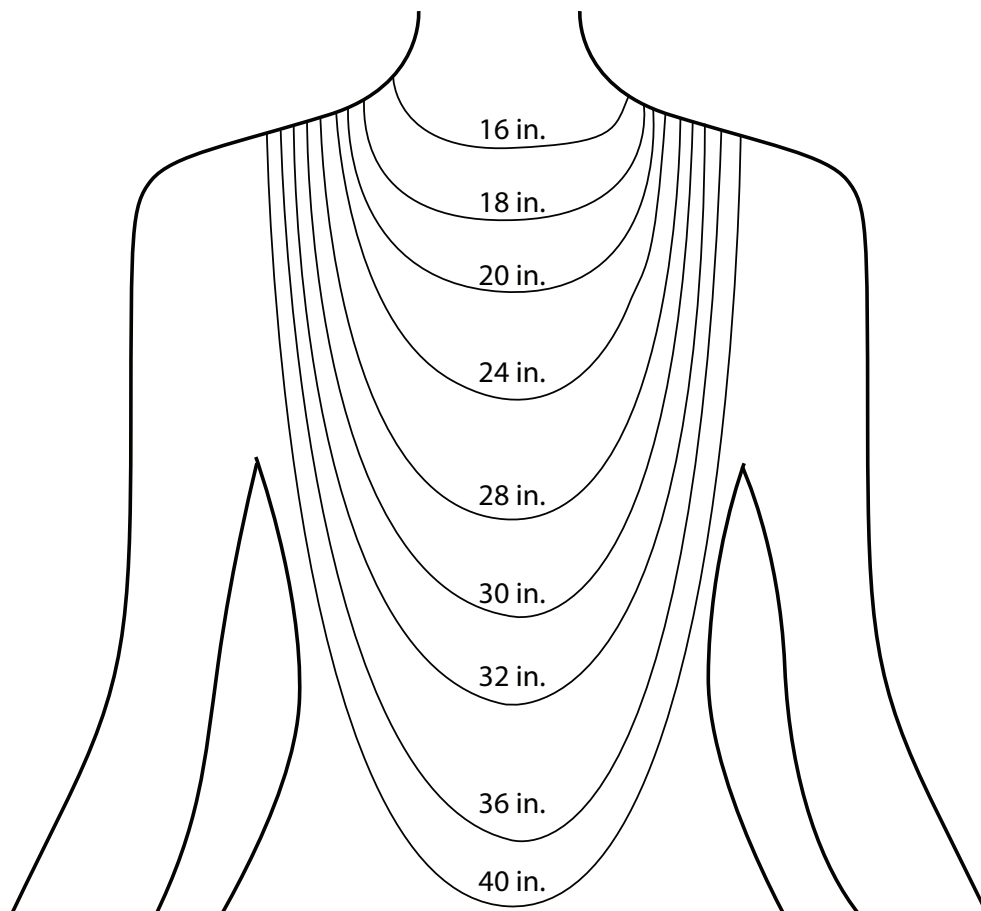
Check your print accuracy by making sure the scale measures exactly 50 mm.

Necklace Size Guide

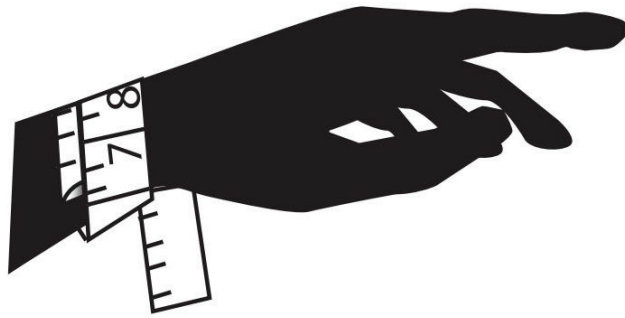


<i>Length</i>	<i>Position on the Body</i>
16 inches	Wraps loosely around the neck
18 inches	Sits on the collarbone
20 inches	Sits just below the collarbone
22 inches	Lays at or just below the center of the bust
24 inches	Sits just below the collarbone
28-38 inches	Hangs below the bust
40+ inches	Hangs below the navel

Bracelet Size Guide

Measure your wrist with a flexible, soft tape measure around the area between your hand and the wrist bone to get your wrist size. You can also use a strip of paper or piece of string, then measure this against a ruler. Add approx. ¼ inches up to 1 inch (½ inch is average) to your actual wrist size, and you will have your approximate bracelet size. The more you add to your wrist size, the lower your bracelet will hang (closer to your hand).

Find Your PANDORA Bracelet Size

Wrap a tape measure tightly around where your wrist is broadest and add 2 cm to the measurement. Next, find the closest bracelet size. Some customers prefer to roll the bracelet over the hand. When measuring for a bracelet that will roll across the hand, measure tightly where your hand is the broadest. If you plan to add a large amount of charms, we recommend the next size up.
